This is a reminder that the Burlington System Division will conduct a meeting on Sunday, June 12, 2022 at Caesars Palace, Las Vegas, Nevada. This meeting is at **1:00pm local time** in the *Florentine Ballroom #2*. Our meeting room is on the Promenade level (3<sup>rd</sup> floor) of the Caesars Palace Conference Center. If there is a change in the time and location of the meeting, we will notify you as soon as we can.

We will cover the following items during this meeting:

- 1) Ensure all System delegates have arrived and that their hotel accommodations are acceptable.
- 2) Ensure that everyone has registered and that there were no issues with your credentials.
- 3) We will go over wages and expenses you are entitled to receive while attending the convention.
- 4) We will discuss any questions that you may have regarding the convention, such as Bylaws changes, Resolutions, or how the convention is conducted.

If you attend **both** meetings, you will be paid one day's pay at the Joint Protective Board rate of pay for Sunday.

During these meetings, candidates for the different National Division offices may drop by to say a few words and ask for your support. This will give you an opportunity to acquaint yourself with the candidates.

The convention will convene on Monday, June 13, 2022, at 9:00am local time and is scheduled to conclude on Wednesday, June 15, 2022. The morning sessions will last from 9:00am to 12:00pm and the afternoon sessions will run from 1:30pm until adjournment. As we represent Burlington System Division at the National Division Convention, the suggested dress attire is business casual (khakis, slacks, or similar, with a collared shirt). It would be much appreciated if the suggested attire were followed while on convention business.

A casual dinner reception for all Convention attendees is planned for **Wednesday evening** (June 15, 2022) from **7:00pm – 11:00pm** in the **Julius Ballroom**. Please plan to attend this event with your family and guests.
